- ✓ Go to page 45 of your student's book (or page 54 of the pdf). There are five texts about some very famous people. Text A refers to *Alfred Nobel*, text B to *Jim Henson*, text C to *Hans Christian Andersen*, text D to *Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart* and text E to *William Shakespeare*. Read the texts and use the companion pdf about any unknown words you may have (or alternatively, use the *google translate* site).
- ✓ After reading the texts, try to answer the following questions using information from the texts:
 1. Why is Nobel considered to be one of the most important inventors?
 2. Where was Henson born? How old was he when he died?
 3. Can we find Andersen's fairy tales only in books?
 4. Why was Mozart considered to be a whiz-kid?
 5. What did Shakespeare build while he was still alive?
